Welcome!

Neighborcare Health at Dearborn Park International School is a health clinic that provides medical and mental health services for students of Dearborn Park International School.

Funding for the Health Center is partially supported by the Families and Education Levy. Neighborcare Health staff members partner with the school nurse at the Health Center to provide high quality coordinated care to students.

Where?

Neighborcare Health at Dearborn Park International School is located on the **lower level of the main building,**

just north of the library and adjoining the northeast classrooms.



Why?

Our goal is to **help students do better in school** by working with them to **solve medical, dental and mental health concerns**. Our care team focuses on **promoting healthy lifestyles and preventing serious illness**.

Our Health Center is part of **Neighborcare Health**, a network of medical, dental, and school-based clinics, serving more than 70,000 patients in Seattle and Vashon Island each year. Neighborcare Health is committed to creating a health care home, that includes medical, dental and mental health care, and encourages long-term relationships between patients and providers.



When?

Neighborcare Health at Dearborn Park International School provides services to all students several days a week before, during and after school hours. **To schedule an appointment for your child, please call 206-548-3166.**

The Health Center is closed during school holidays and summer break. When Neighborcare Health at Dearborn Park International School is closed, students and their families are encouraged to call a Neighborcare Health clinic for medical, dental and mental health services. The closest clinics are **Neighborcare Health at Georgetown** for dental services (206-461-6943) and **Neighborcare Health at Columbia City** for medical services (206-461-6957).

Students and their families are also welcome at any of our Seattle clinic locations (see back cover).



At Neighborcare Health, we believe that everyone deserves a health care home, regardless of income or insurance status. A health care home is where a team of medical, dental and mental health professionals works in collaboration with each patient to develop a personal health improvement plan. It's a place where we encourage long-term relationships with patients and care for them from birth through end of life. No matter which Neighborcare Health clinic patients visit, we want them to feel at home.

What services are offered to students?

Medical and mental health services offered at Dearborn Park International include:

- Evaluation and treatment of common health problems
- Well-child check-ups and physicals
- Preventive health care
- Vaccinations
- Individual, family and group mental health counseling
- Family coordination to establish health care home
- Insurance eligibility and enrollment assistance
- Crisis intervention
- Community and school-based referrals
- Health promotion and health education

Dental services

Any student who is registered as a patient at the Health Center can access Neighborcare Health dental services at any of our dental clinics throughout Seattle (see back cover).

The closest dental clinic to the school is **Neighborcare Health at Georgetown**. Call 206-461-6943 to schedule a dental appointment for your child.



How can students use the center?

Register! Students must register with **Neighborcare Health at Dearborn Park International School** in order to receive care. A complete registration form and consent with parent or guardian signature is all that is needed to access all of the services offered. Families may call or visit Neighborcare Health at Dearborn Park International School if they would like their child to be seen.

Request to Report slips are given for appointments during school. We will do everything possible to schedule or reschedule so students miss as little class as possible. Students may also visit the clinic without an appointment by getting a pass from their teacher or a referral from the school nurse.

What is the cost?

Our intention is to reduce as many barriers as possible to accessing medical and mental health services. **No student will be denied services due to inability to pay.** Because the Families and Education Levy covers only a portion of the costs to operate the Health Center, we bill insurance companies when possible.

We have Eligibility Specialists who work in all of our sites to assist families and students to enroll in health insurance programs. We accept a wide variety of health insurance plans, including Washington Apple Health (Medicaid) and bill them directly for services. Lab services for non-confidential services are billed to the student's health insurance by LabCorp.
