Patient Town Hall: Tue, Aug 4

As changes to Medicaid eligibility affect thousands of Washington residents starting October 1, 2026, many individuals and families face uncertainty about renewing coverage, qualifying for benefits, or accessing affordable healthcare. This event helps remove barriers by providing clear information, one-on-one assistance, and trusted support when patients need it most.
