
Introduction

Neighborcare Health has addressed health inequities since our roots in the civil rights movement in the 1960s, serving the needs of more than 60,000 people annually left behind by conventional health care institutions.


Our ultimate goal has remained the same: 100 percent access; zero health disparities. We provide whole-person care by integrating medical, dental, and behavioral health services across 30 Neighborcare sites in Greater Seattle and Vashon Island.

The Need

Access to dental care is critical to overall health. Yet, thousands of low-income people, people of color, and seniors face pervasive structural inequities that keep access to dental care out of reach for many in our community. Unmet dental health can lead to serious health conditions such as cardiovascular disease, pregnancy complications, and infection. Lack of dental care severely impacts physical and emotional health. It can result in debilitating pain, reduced self-esteem, social exclusion, and impact in career advancement.

Vision for the Future

Neighborcare Health is the largest provider of adult dental care to people living homeless in Seattle. We aim to **serve an additional 2,300 Washingtonians** who currently lack access to dental care.

To achieve this, we seek to add **two more dental spaces** at our 45th Street dental clinic, **increasing capacity for 6,300 more visits**. Renovations will enhance care quality and safety, improve physical and mental health for thousands, and reduce inequities in dental care.

Call to Action

We are grateful to the State of Washington for contributing \$1.75 million towards this campaign on this \$2.57 million project. To reach the finish line, Neighborcare Health Foundation has set a goal to raise at least \$400,000 between now and the close of March 2025 from our generous philanthropic partners.
