Understanding Your Role and Commitment as a Board Member

The Commitment

- 3-year terms with the option to renew
- 9 board meetings per year (2nd Tuesday of the month)
- 6-8 hours of time per month including meetings

Board Member Expectations

- Champion Neighborcare Health in the community and help grow donor relationships
- Support fundraising efforts through events, outreach, and connections
- Encourage your personal network to donate
- Make Neighborcare one of your top three giving priorities
- Annually review the staff-driven work plan, strategies, and goals, and make recommendations
- Attend at least 80% of meetings
- Identify and recruit additional Foundation Board members as needed
- Be responsive to strategic direction from the Governing Board of Neighborcare Health

Neighborcare Health provides medical, dental, behavioral health, and pharmacy to about 60,000 people in our community, most of whom who would otherwise struggle with access to care. We are in over 30 sites including 17 school-based health centers and many supportive housing sites.

As a community health center, we are able to offer services that people need to stay well including: midwifery care, health education, nutrition services, autism diagnosis, and referrals to community partners for many other basic needs.
